### 2024 South and West Regional Orchid Workshop

The regional workshop was hosted by the Shoalhaven Orchid Society this year. The workshop attracted 60 participants with members from at least 12 different societies joining us at the Nowra Golf Club for a weekend of interesting and informative talks, some serious orchid shopping and lots of friendly interaction.

Guest speaker, David Brooks, gave two very informative talks on sarcochilus and cymbidiums. Steve Dunstan spoke on Australian native cymbidiums with particular reference to *Cym. canaliculatum*. He also gave a talk on the Dendrobium Section Latouria - a group of plants that many attendees knew little about but were keen to find some after Steve's talk. Craig Miles' talks had lots of interesting information about setting up orchid growing areas as well as detailing cultural information for both paphiopedilum and miltoniopsis. Shoalhaven club member, Martin Montebello, gave an interesting presentation on growing phalaenopsis as an indoor plant and Brian Phelan demonstrated how he grows *Cattleya (Sophronitis) coccinea* in sphagnum. A wealth of information was shared over the one and a half days and those who attended were fortunate indeed to be able to learn from these experienced and knowledgeable speakers.

The vendors: David Brooks, Craig Miles, Martin Montebello and the Society sales team were kept busy during all of the breaks between talks and the Plant Creche was overflowing with new 'babies' delivered during the workshop. It was a great opportunity to see a huge variety of different genera, both flowering size and seedling size and everything in between. The added bonus was being able to talk to the experts about cultural requirements before making purchases.

Participants were able to enjoy endless cuppas and very tasty morning and afternoon teas as well as a delicious lunch courtesy of our caterers, Diane Slye and Allison Lerch, and the members who prepared the salads. Everyone enjoyed the opportunity to socialise, to catch up with old orchid friends and make new ones. Socialising continued on Saturday evening when a large group of participants met for dinner at the Bomaderry Bowling Club.

Brian Phelan donated a 'large', flowering sized *Cattleya coccinea* for a Lucky Door prize and this was augmented with donations from our vendors and guest speakers as well as some items from our society.
