

SPRING SHOW SUMMARY

There were 159 plants benched plus 2 which weren't eligible for judging. That was up from 145 last year. 19 members benched plants and it was very pleasing that almost half of those members were Novice and Intermediate growers. I think that is the best display we have had on those benches for quite some time. The number of Open exhibitors was down this year but we hope that those who were unable to participate will be available for our October show.

There were 402 visitors through the door and it was pleasing to see some familiar faces – ex-members and non-active members who took the opportunity to enjoy the show.
